Re: **Series 150S Replacement Switch Assemblies**

McDonnell & Miller introduced the new environmentally friendly Series 150S Pump Controllers in September 1996. Since that time, we have learned that customers would like to have access to 150S snap switch replacement assemblies. In response, we are happy to announce that the replacement assemblies are now available as an alternative to replacing the entire 150S head mechanism. Be aware that switch replacements may likely result in high field adjustment costs or other inconveniences. Complete 150S head replacements provide customers with factory set calibration. Consequently, McDonnell & Miller strongly recommends complete head replacement as the best cost effective repair.

The switch assembly includes both the burner and pump switch which are shipped pre-mounted to the switch bracket. Individual snap switches will not be available because each assembly requires factory calibration. Refer to our Replacement Parts Catalog (MM-701) pages 27 or 43, to obtain proper selection and ordering information.

Remember: Series 150S and 157S replacement switch assemblies are not interchangeable with Series 150 and 157 mercury switch controls. Also, the replacement switch assemblies must be selected and ordered for specific Series 150S control model(s) and are not interchangeable. (For example: 150S, 150S-M, and 150S-MDs all require different switch assemblies.)
